## Key Vocabulary

**Pop Art** – Art based on modern popular culture

**Self-Portrait** – A portrait that an artist produces of themselves

**Printing** – The process of creating art by printing

**Patterns** – A repeated decorative design

**Block Printing** – The process of printing patterns using engraved wooden blocks

**Blotting** – An artistic technique used by Andy Warhol using ink and tracing paper.
