A safari is a trip where you look for wild animals.



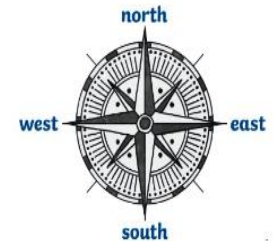
