# What are portraits?

- A portrait is a painting/picture of a person, this can be painted by the artist themselves (self-portrait) or by someone else.
- A portrait can be created in any art medium e.g. paint, chalk, collage etc.

### **Pablo Picasso**

- Pablo Ruiz Picasso (25 October 1881 8 April 1973)
  was a Spanish painter,
  sculptor, printmaker, ceramicist and theatre
  designer.
- He spent most of his adult life in France.
- One of the most influential artists of the 20th century, he is known for co-founding the Cubist movement and other important styles.
- Among his most famous works are Les Demoiselles d'Avignon (1907), and Guernica (1937).

**Subject:** the thing or person being painted **Cubism:** a style of art that uses abstract shapes to represent different parts of a subject.

**Tint**: different colour produced when added white to a colour.

**Tone**: different colour produced when black is added to the colour.
