

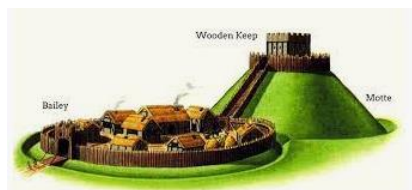

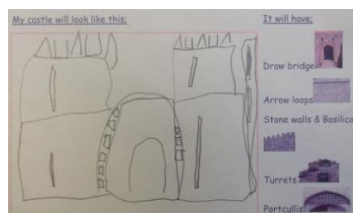

Vocabulary and Explanation

Battlement		Top of the castle where people would shoot arrows from
Portcullis		A strong iron gate, that can be raised to allow the drawbridge to be lowered
Drawbridge		A bridge that can be lowered or raised
Moat		A deep ditch that surrounds the castle. It can have water in there
Turret		Small tower, built at the corner, or on top of a large tower
