

Vocabulary and Explanation

Petal - thin, various colours or white, forms the flower

Flower - often bright colours, grows at the end of the stem

Stem - thin upright on which the flowers and leaves grow

Leaf - usually green on plants


Seed - small, hard part from which a new plant grows

Root - part of the plant which grows underground


Branches - parts that grow out of the trunk of the tree and have leaves

Trunk - brown, large main stem of a tree from which branches grow


Bark - a tough material that covers the outside of the tree.
