# Home-School communication

Reading is very important; the children should read everyday.

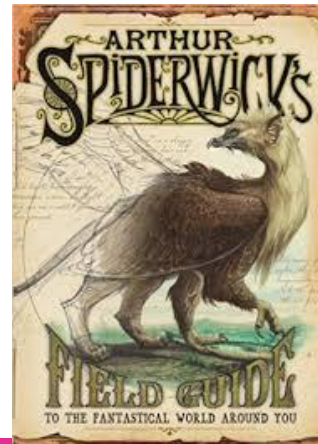
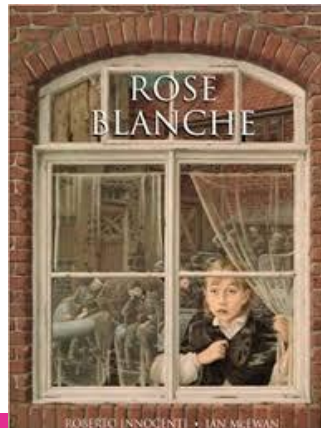
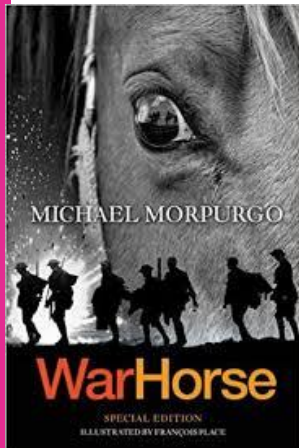

- Please inform us via email/in writing if your child is unable to do PE with a valid reason.

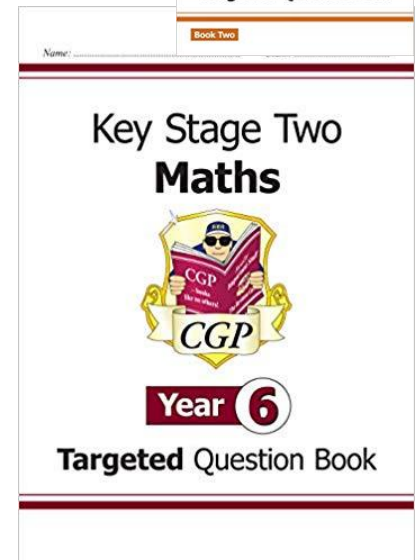
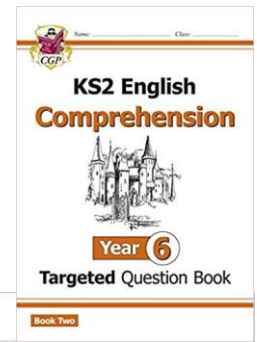
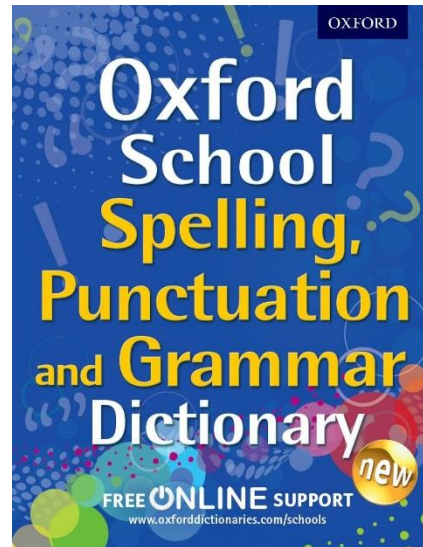
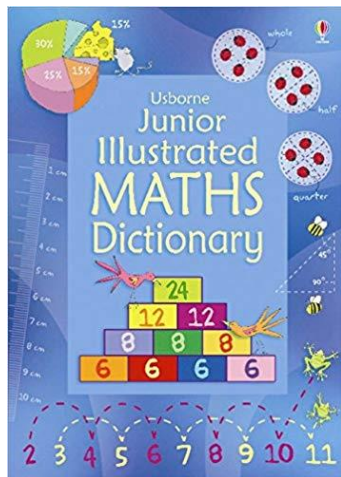


# Parent helpers
