Successful Funding Bid

The government released additional funding for schools under the Healthy Pupils Capital Funding grant-the “sugar tax” fund. Schools had to apply for funding available and as you can imagine it was a highly competitive process. I am thrilled to announce we were successful in securing a £50,000 grant for Our Lady school-this is at least 5 times more than other schools we know of. We plan to use the funding to upgrade the outdoor sporting facilities.
