

Whole School Religious Education Overview 2016-2017

The Religious Education long-term plan is in two parts:-

1. Themes each term (from the Diocesan Units)
2. Scripture reference relating to each theme

Units, resources and support materials from the Diocese of Westminster are used across the school. The Religious Education Curriculum Directory four principal *Areas Of Study and Sources*: Revelation, The Church, Celebration and Life in Christ, the Bible, *Catechism of the Catholic Church* and the liturgy are also used, to develop children's understanding and personal experience of faith and spirituality. Sources are detailed in each class's medium-term and weekly plans. All resources, including the *Wednesday Word*, are used creatively in ways to enhance and inspire pupil's learning.

Each year, all classes will study two other faiths for one week. The faiths studied are Judaism and Sikhism.
