**Equator-** An imaginary line around the centre of the Earth.



**Continent-** A continent is a large area of land. They are easy to spot on a globe/map. They're so large that they can contain many other countries.

6. Antarctica
7. Australia



**Climate-** The average weather conditions in a place.



**Vegetation-** An area that is covered in plants.

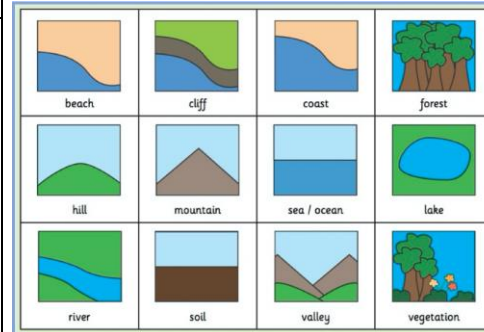
