




Year 5 Parent Information

Summer term 2021





- In Maths this term we will continue to secure the children's number skills, working with larger numbers when using the four operations.
- Every Friday we will introduce 'problem solving' based on the learning that has happened that week. This is a complex area of Maths and always the one children struggle with most!
- It is vital that all children are able to recall their times tables quickly. This helps with every area of Maths. Make sure you are using Times Table Rock Stars at home to help with this.
- We suggest that you are also using the CGP books and My Maths website at home to help support your child's learning.

Our learning this term

- ▶ This term we will be securing key concepts the children were taught during the Autumn and Spring terms. We will focus on key grammar aspects, essential spellings and core maths skills. We will also be preparing the children for their transition to Year 6!
- ▶ In Science we will focus on Animal life cycles and gestation periods and Scientists and Inventors.
- ▶ In History and Geography we will be learning about the Ancient Greeks and South America.
- ▶ Spellings and Times table tests will happen every Tuesday.
- ▶ Homework is uploaded onto seesaw on a Friday and is due in the following Wednesday.






Supporting your child at home
