Our Lady School is committed to maintaining the high standard of uniform worn in the school. Smart and correctly dressed children seen wearing their uniform proudly speaks volumes about the school.

Winter Uniform (Autumn and Spring terms)

- Blue shirt – long or short sleeved
- Grey skirt/pinafore or grey trouser/shorts
- Navy pullover with embroidered school badge on left
- Navy/sky striped tie
- White/navy/grey socks or tights

Infants can wear an elasticated tie.

Outdoor shoes should be sensible and supportive to the foot (secured with laces or straps).

Heavy boots, heeled or platform shoes or open sandals are not acceptable.

Summer Uniform (Summer term)

- As winter uniform but ties do not need to be worn
- Blue/white checked dress and white socks/tights
- Navy cardigan with embroidered school badge on left
- Caps with school logo

PE Kit

All children should have a PE kit in school every day.

- Navy t-shirt with school house colour on the sleeves and navy shorts
- Navy blue heavy weight tracksuit bottoms for sports
- Navy tracksuit tops with embroidered school logo
- Trainers for outdoor activities
- Black/navy football socks

Jewellery

On health and safety grounds we do not allow children to wear jewellery in our school. We do not encourage earrings. However if ears are pierced, only studs should be worn. We ask the children to either remove or cover earrings with a plaster or tape to prevent them from causing injury during P.E./Games lessons. In **exceptional circumstances** we permit children to wear medical wristbands if this has been recommended by a GP/Paediatrician.

Watches

Only watches that are not classed as 'smart watches' can be worn in school. Watches must be limited to the following functions – Telling them time and counting steps.

Hair

Hair styles should be simple and easily managed. Extremes of styles or colours are not permitted. The school requests that the children do not have their hair coloured or shaved in elaborate styles. If hair is able to be tied up, then it should be at all times.

Hair ornaments should be plain and simple. Fancy combs, slides, bobbles and clips and fashion braids can be dangerous, distract children from their learning and should not be worn. We do not permit hair gel.

Cosmetics

We do not permit the children to wear makeup or nail polish to school. If worn, the children will be asked to remove it. We do not permit the children to wear aftershave or perfume.

General

We encourage the children to wear their shirts tucked in with the top buttons closed. Parents are expected to support the school in following our school policy on uniform.
