## Year 4 Multiplication and Times Tables Check in 2 d

What is the purpose of the multiplication tables check or MTC?
The purpose of the MTC is to determine whether year 4 pupils can fluently recall their multiplication tables. It helps the school identify pupils who require additional support.
By the end of year 3, children should be fluent in the 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, 10 times tables.

It will only present children with multiplication statements not division.
The online check will carried out in the three-week period starting Monday 5 June 2023.

It will be fully digital and available on laptops, desktops and tablets.
It'll expected to take less than 5 minutes per pupil.
There is no requirement for all children in a class to take the check all at once.

## Multiplication Tests Continued

- Each question will only be on the screen for 6 seconds.
- This means to read, recall and enter their response within 6 seconds.
- Children will be presented with 25 questions.
- There will be a 3 second pause in-between each question.
- It is important that children are used to answering questions in quick succession before they face the test.

## Science

Alongside the homework set we expect all children to read for at least 20 minutes a day and recording this in their green homework diary. We will sign their reading diaries on Thursday and Friday.
We also expect children to be practising their times tables and spellings at least three times a week.
