Science

Forces and magnets

Explore how forces make objects move, speed up, slow down or change direction. Explore magnets and magnetic materials.

Health and Movement

Learn how animals, including humans, need specific nutrition to help them move and grow, and how humans and some other animals have skeletons and muscles to help their bodies move.

Light and Shadows

Learn about how light travels, what shadows are, how the length and position of a shadow changes throughout the day and much more.

Mathematics

Addition and subtraction: We are learning to add and subtract any 3-digit numbers together, including those that involve regrouping.

Multiplication and division: Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4 and 8 multiplication tables.

We will also be multiplying a 2-digit number by a 1-digit number and dividing a 2-digit number by a 1-digit number.

Measurements: Length and Perimeter. We will be finding equivalent lengths and explore what perimeter is and how to calculate it.
